Bottles of special glitter were prepared for each member by Sister Eatta. It's a fun way of spreading joy and fun. We have blessed many people and have had to fill some bottles up 3 times. Eatta cares about our earth so she used recycled essential oil bottles (they kind of looks like a poppers bottle – added fun!) Eatta is also looking for an environmentally friendly glitter option that she would like to be gluten free and safe for animals. I will continue to make each new member coming in a first vile of sparkling joy to get them started.



SISTER AIDA BAGUETTE - June 2019: Devotional Candles

Sister Aida Baguette undertook a candle making / selling project as her novice project. Sister Aida created a series of prayer candles featuring a few different slogans and a few featuring a few of our current sisters. She purchased plain candles and then created the designs on them using clear sticker sheets that were stuck on. The candles were obtained for around \$5 each and the portion of the sticker sheet was around \$1. We were selling them for around \$15-\$20 so we were making around \$9-\$14 profit on each one, depending on the size of the candle. The type of candle we were using depended on what was available.

These candles were sold at our events thus far, making around \$160 so far. The candles have been sold at around 5 events so far and they will be an ongoing item that the sisters will continue to sell as long as there seems to be a demand for them!

Purpose: spread community joy by sending positive notes between community members z/small amount of fundraising through payment for mailboxes and notes.

Demona purchased materials for this project: fillable plastic Easter eggs (they look like Kinder Surprise Eggs), popping candy, chocolates. Condoms were from supplies from our packaging efforts prior. Each egg was filled with these treats and condoms, as well as a handwritten note that hopefully inspired some joy and well-wishes among the recipients. There were five different messages used in five eggs each. One of the message examples was:

"For mine is the ecstasy of the spirit, and mine is also joy on earth; for my law is love unto all beings. For behold All acts of love and pleasure are my rituals" - from, The Charge of the Goddess ~ Doreen Valiente

These messages were included to espouse our sister values of no shame, and to promote safer sex practices. It was well received by everyone who received the surprise Kinder egg.
